



# SINGLE GAME VOUCHER POLICY

**THE PURPOSE OF THIS POLICY IS TO CLARIFY THE USE OF SINGLE GAME VOUCHERS TO OUR MEMBERS. WHOM NEEDS TO HAVE ONE. WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THESE VOUCHERS.**

Single Game Vouchers are issued to the Association by Netball WA as a way to ensure that players are covered within our competitions for insurance purposes. At the end of the competition these vouchers are remitted to Netball WA to ensure that should an insurance claim occur that the player concerned is eligible to claim insurance.

This also means they need to be recorded on the scorecard.

- Single Game Vouchers covers a player to play a game, the cost of the voucher is \$10 and it covers your insurance for that game only. Players using these game vouchers are not recorded in mynetball for that year.
- Single Game vouchers can only be used twice in any given year or competition. On the third playing date a player whom has filled in for two separate clubs, must register in my netball with the club they played with on that third date.
- KDNA policy is that all players are registered after the third playing date. Should a player have used two single game vouchers, this does not come off their season fees.
- Players whom are filling in and are registered with another Association do not have to pay for a single game voucher as they are already covered by Netball WA Affiliation.
- Players whom are late to register with a team for the competition are not required to purchase a single game voucher as they will already be registered in mynetball and therefore being charged by the clubs for membership.
- Clubs should be made aware that if a player takes the court once & is registered in mynetball, that play is liable for the Netball WA Affiliation fee.
