



# UNFINANCIAL PLAYERS POLICY

The policy is to clarify the procedure to clubs around the process of players whom are unfinancial and play match play. KDNA have a policy that all players whom have played three games must be registered in mynetball and be financial through there clubs. This means that the first three weeks are usually an opportunity for players to become financial to their clubs or make arrangements to pay. KDNA are not in the business of chasing membership funds of individuals as we deal with the clubs directly.

## **KDNA wish to support clubs the following process has been set up.**

- Club must contact the new Club initially (if within KDNA) and advise of the unfinancial player/s, if they do not know where the player is playing the club is to notify KDNA.
- Once we are aware of the situation and after there has been no resolution between the player and the club, KDNA will forward a standard letter to the new club as well as the individual stating the penalties and that they are not allowed to take the court
- KDNA will also notify Netball WA to advise of the unfinancial player should the situation not be resolved or the player goes to play for another Association.
- Once a player has taken the court for another club, that club will be notified that they have played an unfinancial player.
- After the first three weeks in the grading period, should a club play an unfinancial player they will be notified that any further occurrences will result in a forfeited
- KDNA are trying to establish a way in mynetball to identify unfinancial player flags for clubs registering new players to the club.
- At the end of the season, clubs are asked to send a list of unfinancial players to KDNA Administrator so that they may monitor those individuals.
