



DEVELOPMENT OFFICER UMPIRING

The following responsibilities have been set with the Development Officer –
Umpiring with an annual honorarium (off court component)

Administration

- Chairperson of Umpire Development Committee.
- Ensure access to electronic medium for allocation, training and other activities as needed by the umpire committee.
- Ensure suitable equipment is available to be able to develop and educate umpires.
- Review Budget costs and make recommendations in the best interest of the Association.

Squad

- Work closely with Umpire Convenor, Testing Co-ordinator, Green Shirt & Umpire Coaches to achieve the annual goals.
- Recommend Talent identify umpiring squad to Netball WA Umpire Staff.
- Identify development requirements for umpiring and create opportunities to achieve them.
- Provide goals and outcomes to the KDNA Board as a way of measuring success.
- Provide opportunities for umpires to develop at all levels of the game ie KDNA Premier League, Regional Carnivals and State Academy.
- Provide mentoring and training to Umpire Coaches.
- Present Rules discussions to all participants of the Association.

Association

- Supervisor the organisation and rostering of umpires for Association Carnivals in conjunction with the Carnival Co-ordinator.
- Rank and Roster umpires for KDNA Finals Series in consultation with the Umpire Convenor.
- Develop and review umpiring structures within the Association in the best interest of all participants.
- Work closely with the Assoc Teams Co-ordinator to assist in education of coaches/players.

Development

- Attend any professional development as required- forums, presenters courses/up skill.
- Submit all paperwork for Testing to Netball WA in a timely manner.

Qualifications

- Current minimum National B or preferred A Badge Holder.
- Current Level 1 Umpires Course.
- Current Rules in Action 3 parts.
- Current Theory 1 Exam 90%.
- Netball Australia On-line-Mentor Course Certificate.
- Working With Children Check.
- Testers Certificate minimum B or preferred A.
- Completed Hobby Form for ATO.

Staff Responsibilities

- Manager & Develop all personnel in the umpire unit whom are answerable this role.
