Association Members Championships



The Fuel To Go & Play Member Association Championships is scheduled to be played on the Long Weekend of 5th, 6th & 7th June at the Gold Netball Centre and the Perth Netball Association in Jolimont.

We have 13 teams competing over the 3 days. The Final Team lists are available on the Website with Photos to come soon as well.

With restrictions of social distancing still in place as set by government bodies, it would be great to see us all get out and support our players at this event.

Please see the details below listed from Netball WA regarding the Championships;

Competition Draw Layout;

Association age groups will be divided into two (2) 'Hubs' across the 3 day event.

Hub 1 will include the following age groups:
12U, 13U, 17U

Hub 2 will include the following age groups:
14U, 15U, Open, Masters

Day of Competition	AM	PM

Sunday 6th June	Hub 1	Hub 2
Monday 7th June	Hub 1	Hub 2

There will be mandatory contact tracing at both venues and patrons will be required to scan in upon entry.

Venue limits will be determined by the one person per 2sqm whilst physical distancing of 1.5m must be maintained where possible, when not participating in match play.

NO PERSON is to attend the Fuel to Go & Play Association Championships if they are sick, have a temperature, feel unwell or if they have been in contact with another person who has been sick.

Alcohol based hand sanitisers will be available across both venues and is recommended to be used upon entry, during the day and before exiting.

Smoking at the Courts

The Kalamunda & Districts Netball Association Inc. is required to comply with legislation and the legal duty of care to have a SmokeFree club. This applies to all members, administrators, officials, coaches, players, visitors and volunteers of the Kalamunda & Districts Netball Association Inc. As such, we have the following Designated as Smoke Free Areas;

- Club and social rooms
- Administration & office areas
- Changing rooms
- Toilet blocks
- Court area inside & outside of the building & walkways.
- Eating areas
- Near open windows (ten metre radius around open windows)
- Near entries and exits of buildings, facilities, and the outside Court Area (ten metre radius)



We acknowledge that we do have smokers on the grounds and encourage them to use the area across from the carpark in the entry way, not in the committee parking bay.
